## Description

The local mountain in a sunny location. This mountain which provides superb views is covered with a mat of Alpine grasses up to the summit area and is the second highest elevation in the **Lasörlinggruppe**. The views extend to the **Venedigergruppe**, the **Rieserfernergruppe**, **Glocknergruppe**, **Schobergruppe** through to the **Lienzer Dolomiten** and the **Carnic Alps**.

The **Stanzling** is a tour for experts. Ascent: from **Pfisker-Höfen** along a forest road (around 30 minutes) to the junction for **Hofer Lacke**, **Riegel** and **Stanzling**. Pass the idyllic play and rest area "**Hofer Lacke**", through the still mown mountain pastures, the route proceeds steeply up the slopes which enjoy a sunny aspect. The climatically favourable south side provides a great variety of Alpine flora, the otherwise rare Edelweiß thrives here, being plentiful and looking superb. With a bit of luck you might be able to spot the alpine ibex colony which has settled here over the past few years. However, the steep grassy slopes are slippery when it is wet and these require care and surefootedness.
